



VISITOR GUIDELINES

Effective: 11/5/21

To help prevent the spread of COVID-19 across our care locations, the following guidelines will be followed:

- All visitors will be screened for a history of COVID-19 and flu-like symptoms, such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath, and will **not** be permitted if symptomatic.
- Only visitors who are fully vaccinated or have a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours will be allowed to enter the facility.
- All visitors, regardless of vaccination status or test result, must follow proper infection prevention practices:
 - 1. **Wear a well-fitting face mask** (a surgical mask or double masking is recommended) upon entry and at all times within the facility;
 - 2. Wear any other personal protective equipment (PPE) while in the patient's or resident's room that facility personnel deem appropriate to the situation; and
 - 3. **Physically distance** from facility personnel and other patients/residents/visitors that are not part of their group at all times while in the facility.
- **Up to two healthy 16 years of age and above visitors simultaneously per patient Per Day for ONLY 15 minutes during visitation hours of 7:00pm-9:00pm.**
- To ensure the patient's safety and practice physical distancing, SCH-Van Nuys staff will escort the visitor to the designated visitation area and visitors cannot roam the hallways.
- All communication with hospital staff should be done by phone from outside the hospital.
- Visitors are **ONLY** allowed in the designated area and time frame:
 - **Unit 1**
 - **Location:** Patio
 - **Time:** 7:00pm-9:00pm
 - **Unit 2**
 - **Location:** Dining room
 - **Time:** 7:00pm-9:00pm
- All visitors must sign in on a log including name, date, contact information, and whom they wish to visit before entering the Facility. The Facility will maintain the sign-in log.
